Program Associate, International Programs

The Program Associate provides direct support for the operations of the International Programs department. You will serve as a relationship and information management liaison with partners in Latin America and the Caribbean while supporting Episcopal Relief & Development's core values and strategic goals.

As Program Associate, you will:

- Support the grant management of partner relationships in the Latin American region through office and site visits, regional meetings, phone calls and emails
- Ensure data integrity while managing and maintaining all partner proposal development and contract documentation
- Train, coach and accompany partners to advance the organization's strategic foci
- Test and provide feedback on opportunities to promote experiential training programs and toolkits for developing the global program in the Latin American & Caribbean region
- Provide administrative and logistical support for the department, including but not limited to, report generation, proposal reviews and approvals, MOUs, financial compliance and input and workshop and training planning and implementation
- Learn and develop acumen in emerging methods for crosscutting program objectives that affect women, children and climate resilience
- Support resource mobilization by assisting proposal writing teams, reviewing drafts, ensuring information accuracy and reporting to donors as required
- Collaborate inter-departmentally on a wide array of communications for internal and external audiences

- A detail-oriented multi-tasker who is adept at managing competing priorities and meeting deadlines in a fast-paced environment
- An enthusiastic team member who is excited to work cross-functionally with other departments and a diverse array of community and faith-based actors with tact, diplomacy and sensitivity to cultural diversity
- Interested in disaster and refugee response programs with a demonstrated ease and facility in working remotely with digital communication methods

You Have:
