

EASTER EGG HUNT

For Home

This Easter egg hunt is designed for families to explore the **ONE THOUSAND DAYS OF LOVE** campaign. Adding the nine Gifts that Nurture Children with facts and actions to your Easter eggs is sure to inspire storytelling, song and learning for children of all ages.

Children's early life forms the basis for future learning, good health and well-being. Episcopal Relief & Development's Integrated Early Childhood Development (ECD) programs ensure that children under six, particularly children under three, are reaching their cognitive, language, social, emotional and physical developmental milestones. Investing in children and their primary caregivers during this time can result in lifelong benefits.

Instructions:

- Print the Gifts that Nurture Children illustrations 8.5 x 11 PDF and the Gifts that Nurture Children facts and actions 8.5 x 11 PDF.
- Match the documents up back-to-back and glue them together (or print on a double-sided printer).
- Cut the double-sided document apart into nine squares and put each square into an Easter egg.

OR

- After printing, do not attach the illustrations to the facts and actions so you have 18 squares to add to the eggs and it becomes a matching game.

Adults: This year our Easter egg hunt has special pictures and words to learn what children up to 3 years old need to feel nurtured, loved and to thrive and learn. After we find all the eggs and enjoy our treats, we will read and act out each gift together.
