In the advent of COVID, the increased behavior change campaign in the program area of Episcopal Relief & Development's partner the Anglican Church of Angola is ensuring that everyone in the household is practicing handwashing by that ushering in a new generation of hand washers who began the practice so early in life. In this phot young Antonio was seen washing his hands in Tema, Songo Municipality in Angola.

Tema is one of 81 communities in the northern Angolan province of Uige where Episcopal Relief & Development has partnered the Anglican Church of Angola to scale up a water, sanitation and hygiene project called Maza yi Moyo. The project supported the development of 126 improved water sources serving a population of over 42,000 people.
