

## *Act of Love Cards*

*What will be your Act Of Love?*

**Instead of focusing on what divides us, concentrate on what unites us on November 13, the Day of Love.**

**This deck of twenty-four Acts Of Love cards is for all ages and designed to be shared at church or at home.**

**For church,** print multiple sets of cards onto cardstock and cut apart. Place in a container where parishioners can see them and encourage all to take a card and share with others.

**At home,** print one set of cards and cut them apart. Families can compete to see who can complete the most Acts Of Love.

**Online,** take a photo of the Act of Love you completed and post your Act Of Love on Instagram or Facebook #EpiscopalRelief.

Pro tips for churches: Publish a “Save the Date” in bulletins, e-newsletters, on Facebook and Instagram. Begin offering cards early October. If you run out, simply print more. Place cards in the pews for parishioners to pick up or have ushers to hand cards out as people leave worship.

Printing suggestion: Print the cards double-sided if possible. If not, just print the action items side of the cards and then cut them apart.  
Print the tabletop sign and fold in half to place next to the container.
