





## Children










## Women












# Climate








## Disaster Relief

In collaboration with local Anglican and ecumenical partners, we respond to emergencies, both natural and human-caused, in the US and around the world — providing assistance to help alleviate suffering, restore dignity and jumpstart economic recovery. With support from Episcopal Relief & Development, church and other partners deliver critical supplies such as food, water and other basics, and remain present long after the crisis is over to help communities heal, recover and rebuild long-term.

Being, doing, and giving our very best is how we are good stewards of God's abundance.




